

As a South Shore resident, Ibie currently serves as a proud member of the South Shore Works Board as Secretary. Ibie is a Civitas Child Law Fellow J.D. and M.P.P. Graduate from the Loyola University Chicago School of Law. In her first year of law school, she founded Stand Up For Each Other, Chicago! (SUFEO) to address the school to prison pipeline and support student rights in the school discipline process. Meanwhile she worked with State Senator Kimberly Lightford to amend the Illinois school code by writing and passing SB565 which implemented social emotional screenings into health examinations.

After law school, she worked for Common Cause as their youth organizer and state outreach engagement manager on democracy campaigns. In 2019, Ibie became the Chief of Staff for State Senator Robert Peters of the 13th District. She built his office based on radical transparency which led to continual listening sessions throughout his district.

Ibie believes that people are surviving not thriving and the disinvestment black communities endure daily is something that cannot be ignored. Since then, she has been working for the State's Office of Minority Economic Empowerment (DCEO) as well as supporting the economic efforts of the South Shore Works and South Shore Chamber's Economic Development committee.
